The festival brings youth and families in the community together for a day of fun. The event is open to the public and includes a free wristband to the park, back-to-school supplies, lunch, and other fun activities.

Approximately 60 exhibitors from the area volunteer to attend the event. These exhibitors offer various information and resources surrounding health and education for children and families. YSS staff and community volunteers join by handing out school supplies and lunch, making arts and crafts with children, and ensuring the great resources in our community are shared with parents and guardians.

Several exhibitors such as the Wheeling Nailers, West Virginia Northern Community College, Oglebay Good Zoo, Northwood Health Systems, and many more return each year to provide community entertainment, information on higher education, and resources for health care.

The community highly anticipates this event. Families begin lining up hours before the event starts, with thousands of attendees yearly. YSS provides a free wristband to the park, offering entry to the pool, mini-golf, and boat rides around the pond. The agency also provides activities like inflatables from Tripp's Fun Zone, table games, and free lunches for families.

Special Events Coordinator, Holly Fox, says, “I’m excited about the community coming together for a day of fun.” Fox explains, “We offer various games, interactive crafts, prizes, and more.”

Jill Eddy, YSS CEO, says, “We are fortunate to have wonderful resources for children and families in the valley and look forward to making sure they are provided these resources to promote success this school year.” Eddy continues, “Student and family success aligns with our mission, ‘To Create Better Futures for Children, Families, and the Community.’”
